





Here is an interesting statistic for you. As I look back in our church's records, I realized that I have done more baptisms than funerals!! And that is almost underheard of in rural congregation like ours. So I thank you for not dying.

I want to lift up one other thing. As of right now, January 29th, our year to date goal for offering is \$67,830 and our actual offering received is: \$66,296.47. That is \$1,533.53 behind our goal, which isn't too bad! I'm a numbers nerd and enjoy looking at spreadsheets (yes, I'm weird, but we already knew that). Historically, January is our worst month for giving and attendance and this year was no different, in fact, it was the worst one yet. But we have an amazing congregation and I am humbled and honored to serve as your pastor. Old Business

Technology upgrades: a new transmitter was purchased and it is working really well. A newlap has been discussed. Mick moved/Tim seconded approval to purchase a \$449 laptop at Office Max. Motion carried.

Opening prayer by Pastor Pete: "Anguish Into Light" from Isaiah 53:11

Approval of December minutes: Margaret moved/Connie seconded approval of minutes. Carried.

Reports

Treasurers- Connie moved/Donna seconded approval of Treasurer's report as presented. Carried.

Education Committee- Pastor Pete has emailed parents with children regarding VBS and their preference as to the 3rd week in June or a week in July. Awaiting responses.

Altar Guild-the sanctuary is always taken care of. Lots of folks helped to take down the Christmas decorations.

Worship Committee- Christmas Eve Services: 2pm service-51 attendees, 6:30pm service-86 attendees. There were many new faces. A great turnout for the first time offering two services.

Kitchen Committee- Typically a decision is made as to how to distribute funds earned during the year at the January Kitchen Committee meeting, but there were not enough members present to have a quorum. Decision will be made and reported to the Council during their February meeting. Start-up fund is generally \$5000. Currently they have a balance of \$15,338.75!

Properties/Maintenance Committee- Wade Julin reached out to Council member Sue Wells and asked if we would like to have our snowbanks pushed back. He has acquired a new piece of equipment. Cost is \$125/hour, but it needs to be done as our parking lot is "closing in" with all the snow we have had. Should be done sometime this week.

Pastor's comments and concerns-Pastor has been working on Parochial reports this week. In looking back over all that has happened in the last year (s), there were some interesting findings. We currently have 181 members "on the books" with 140 "active" members. Also, he has performed more baptisms than funerals over the last 4 years. Wonderful news!

Old Business

Misc. repairs- Kelly Booge was not happy with the quality of door handles anywhere in town, so he ordered some and they have arrived. With the nice weather coming this week, he likely will get the door handles replaced this week as well as the sprayer in the kitchen repaired. John Rubash offered to assist.

New Business

Winter weather and cancellations-reminder that generally the decision to cancel church services will be determined by the Pastor and Council President (or the next Council member in line if President is unavailable). Cancellation notice will be available on Facebook, via email, a radio announcement and/or a telephone call. A Master Directory list has been passed around church to make sure that each of has verified our contact information is correct.

Coming attractions

Wayne and Olivia Hoff have asked if we might be interested in a Mardi Gras event as Nary School is under construction. Tentative date is 2/22/20. Pastor Pete will contact them to get more details and communicate with the Council via email for vote.

Lenten services begin 2/26 which is Ash Wednesday. Services will be at 7pm, with soup/sandwich beginning at 6pm.

Good Friday service time is yet to be determined.

Easter Sunday is 4/12/20.

5/16/20- Pastor will officiate at the wedding of Kyla Langerak and Brady Hannem.

Summer Festival- tentative date 7/12/20

Grubby Sunday-start to make a list of things that need sprucing up. The north outside wall of the church could use a power wash. Wendy offered the use of her power washer.

2021 will be the 125th Anniversary of Aardahl. We will need a committee to plan a celebration.

Adjournment- 7:25pm Connie moved/Donna seconded meeting be adjourned. Carried. Lord's Prayer led by Pastor Pete.
